Record Of Competence

Successful completion of a work-based Record of Competence (RoC) is a programme requirement. The RoC consists of three sections:

Supplementary Outcomes

The assessment comprises a 90-minute written examination with two sections:

Part A - 45 multiple-choice questions (MCQ)

Part B – 30 extended matching questions (EMQ)

Examinations are conducted biannually in March and September.

- 1. Successfully complete and fulfil the requirements of the Record of Competence (RoC).
- 2. Pass the examination


